

**St. Albans City Council
Liquor Control Board
Minutes of Meeting
Monday, June 8, 2015
City Hall, Council Chambers**

A regular meeting of the St. Albans City Liquor Control Board was held on Monday, June 8, 2015, in council chambers at City Hall.

Council Present: Mayor Elizabeth Gamache; Aldermen: Tim Hawkins, Scott Corrigan, Jim Pelkey, Chad Spooner and Alderwomen Tammi DiFranco & Kate Laddison.

Council Absent: None absent.

1. Call To Order. The meeting was called to order at 6:56 p.m. by Mayor Gamache who presided.
2. Liquor License Applications.

Ms. Krupp explained that South Main Grocery is under new management and seeking a Second Class Liquor License. The Traveled Cup is also being purchased and seeking a First Class Liquor License. Mayor Gamache asked Ms. Krupp if South Main Grocery has new ownership or just new management. Ms. Krupp responded that she believes the business is still in the same family. Mr. Hawkins asked Ms. Krupp for the background on South Main Grocery in terms of violations. Ms. Krupp responded that there have been no violations in the last two years.

 - a. SM Mart LLC – South Main Grocery – Second Class Liquor License.
 - b. Village Cone & Coffee LLC – The Traveled Cup – First Class Liquor License.

A motion was made by Alderman Hawkins; seconded by Alderman Pelkey to approve second class liquor license application for SM Mart LLC first class liquor license for Village Cone & Coffee LLC. Vote was unanimous, 7-0.
3. Minutes of previous meeting – 5/18/15 (D&V).

A motion was made by Alderman Hawkins; seconded by Alderman Spooner to approve meeting minutes from 5/18/15. Motion carried, 6-0 with Alderman Spooner abstaining.
4. Other Business.

Ms. Krupp stated that BBQ & Noodle will be appearing before the Vermont Liquor Control Board on July 1st to consider suspension or revocation of their First Class License.

Hannah Lyford, new owner of The Traveled Cup introduced herself along with Imran Asad, new manager of South Main Grocery. Mayor Gamache indicated that both of their requests have been approved.
5. Adjourn.

A motion was made by Alderman Pelkey; seconded by Alderman Hawkins to adjourn from Liquor Control Board at 7:01 pm. Vote was unanimous, 7-0.
