Regarding the Taylor Park Master Planning Project

Approved by vote of the Council on January 9, 2017

It is hereby resolved...

As members of the Parks Commission, City Staff, and the Steering Committee of park stakeholders go forth on this project, the City Council charges you to consider the following:

1. Maintain an inclusive process that welcomes and integrates a broad range of public input.
2. Engage in a forward-looking project that formulates ambitious and shared short-and long-term visions for the Park.
3. Balance the following goals in your visioning and planning:
 - a. increase Taylor Park's capacity to accommodate events and other activities that contribute to the economic vitality of the City,
 - b. maintain the park's ability to host, and perhaps expand, current activities and uses, and
 - c. improve the park's built infrastructure and natural environment.
4. Provide the City with well thought-out plans that will guide coordinated improvements to the Park, both large and small in scale.
