CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION TO REAPPORTION THE CITY WARDS

WHEREAS, the St. Albans City Charter states that the City Council is "empowered to make such changes from time to time, by resolution or ordinance, in the number and boundaries of the several wards of the city as it may deem proper;" and

WHEREAS, the last City Ward boundary reapportionment was adopted by the City Council December 9, 1968; and

WHEREAS, analysis of the 2020 decennial U.S. Census block data shows significant population deviations between the existing wards in the 1968 Ward Boundaries map; and

WHEREAS, 2020 U.S. Census blocks can be assembled with redistricting data tools to produce wards with more acceptable degrees of deviation between total resident population; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby reapportions the six City Wards, effective immediately, as follows:

WARD 1 SHALL BE that portion of the City of St. Albans encompassed within a boundary beginning at the intersection of Congress Street and U.S. Route 7; then northerly along the western side of the centerline of U.S. Route 7 to the intersection of Lower Newton Street; then westerly along the southern side of the centerline of Lower Newton Street to the Stevens Brook; then northerly along the Stevens Brook to the boundary line of the Town of St. Albans.; then easterly along the town boundary line and following the town line to the intersection of Congress Street; then westerly along the southern side of the centerline of Congress Street to of point of beginning.

WARD 2 SHALL BE that portion of the City of St. Albans encompassed within a boundary beginning at the point where the southwestern boundary line of the Town of St. Albans intersects with the property boundary between 2 Bowles Lane and 28 Guyette Circle; then northwesterly along the town boundary line and then follow the town boundary line to the Stevens Brook; then southerly along the Stevens Brook to the intersection of Lower Newton Street; then southeasterly along the northern side of the centerline of Lower Newton Street to the intersection of Federal Street; then southerly along the eastern side of the centerline of Federal Street to the intersection of Aldis Street; then westerly along the southern side of centerline of Aldis Street to the Stevens Brook; then southerly along the Stevens Brook to the intersection of Pearl Street; then westerly along the southern side of the centerline of Pearl Street to the intersection of Cedar Street; then southerly along the eastern side of the centerline of Cedar Street to the intersection of Lake Street; then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Lake Street to the intersection of Edward Street; then southerly along the eastern side of the centerline of Edward Street to the boundary between 2 Bowles Lane and 28 Guyette Circle; then southerly along the boundary between 2 Bowles Lane and 28 Guyette Circle to of point of beginning.

WARD 3 SHALL BE that portion of the City of St. Albans encompassed within a boundary beginning at the intersection of Lake Street and U.S. Route 7; then westerly along the southern side of the centerline of Lake Street to the intersection of Cedar Street; then northerly along the western side of the centerline of Cedar St. to the intersection of Pearl Street; then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Pearl Street to the Stevens Brook; then northerly along the Stevens Brook to the intersection of Aldis Street; then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Aldis Street to the intersection of Federal Street; then northerly along the western side of the centerline of Federal Street to the intersection of Lower Newton Street; then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Lower Newton Street to the intersection of U.S. Route 7; then southerly along the eastern side of the centerline of U.S. Route 7 to the point of beginning.

WARD 4 SHALL BE that portion of the City of St. Albans encompassed within a boundary beginning at the intersection of Diamond Street and U.S. Route 7; then northerly along the eastern side of the centerline of U.S. Route 7 to the intersection of Congress Street; then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Congress St. to the boundary line of the Town of St. Albans; then southerly along the town line to the intersection of Fairfield Street; then westerly along the southern side of the centerline of Fairfield Street to the intersection of Lincoln Avenue; then southerly along the western side of the centerline of Lincoln Avenue to the intersection of Diamond Street; then westerly along the southern side of the centerline of Diamond St. to the point of beginning.

WARD 5 SHALL BE that portion of the City of St. Albans encompassed within a boundary beginning at intersection of Diamond Street and U.S. Route 7; then easterly along the southern side of the centerline of Diamond Street to the intersection of Lincoln Avenue; then northerly along the eastern side of the centerline of Lincoln Avenue to the intersection of Fairfield Street; then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Fairfield Street to the boundary line of the Town of St. Albans; then southerly along the town line of the Town of St. Albans to the intersection with U.S. Route 7; then northerly along the western side of centerline of U.S. Route 7 to the point of beginning.

WARD 6 SHALL BE that portion of the City of St. Albans encompassed within a boundary beginning at the point where the southwestern boundary line of the City of St. Albans intersects with the property boundary between 2 Bowles Lane and 28 Guyette Circle; then northeasterly along the property boundary between 2 Bowles Lane and 28 Guyette Circle to the intersection of Bowles Lane, Guyette Circle and Edward Street; then northeasterly along the eastern side of the centerline of Edward Street to the intersection of Lake Street then easterly along the northern side of the centerline of Lake Street to the intersection of U.S. Route 7; then southerly along the eastern side of the centerline of U.S. Route 7 to the southern-most edge of the boundary line between the City and Town of St. Albans, then northwesterly along the town line of the Town of St. Albans and then follow the town line to the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council shall reapportion the City Wards within one year of the release of decennial U.S. Census data, and not less than every ten years, however this current resolution to reapportion the City Wards shall remain in effect until such time that a
