ARTICLE 3: TIF BOND REDEVELOPMENT BONDS


Shall the City of St. Albans issue general obligation bonds or notes in an amount not to exceed \$11.4 million for the purpose of financing Tax Increment Financing District public improvements, parking construction, site work, roadway construction, streetscaping, professional services, and rate costs and for the payment thereof pledge the credit of the City, in particular the revenues generated from the Tax Increment Financing District?

Voters are hereby notified that the above total includes up to \$2.5 million in related costs to be reimbursed by the tax increment finance district.

To date, the cumulative amount of Tax Increment Financing District Debt authorized and incurred is \$21 Million, of which \$13.4 million is outstanding. Of the \$21 million, up to \$2.4 million has been authorized for related costs. If the increment received by the City from any property tax source received by the City is insufficient to pay debt service on the indebtedness identified above, in any year for whatever reason, including a decrease in property value or repeal of a state property tax source, unless determined otherwise at the time of such repeal, the City shall remain liable for such debt service for the term of such indebtedness.




