ASK THE CITY

How will the proposed FY27 budget impact my taxes?

On March 3rd voters will be asked to adopt the City Council's proposed budget for FY27 totaling \$15,515,530 with an estimated tax rate of 0.7156 per \$100 of assessed value. This budget focuses on cost stability while prioritizing public safety and maintaining core services. It includes a 2.2% increase to the municipal tax levy, which is below the current inflation rate. For a home assessed at the citywide residential average of \$340,000, this results in an annual tax increase of \$50.

For taxpayers interested in estimating the impact on their property, the municipal tax amount is calculated by taking the assessed value of property (found on the current tax bill), dividing it by \$100, and multiplying it by the tax rate. For example, a residential property assessed at \$340,000 could expect the FY27 municipal tax to be \$2,433 ($\$340,000 / \100×0.7156) which is a \$50 increase from the current year of \$2,383 ($\$340,000 / \100×0.7010).
