ARTICLE 5: CHARTER AMENDMENT, CITY CLERK

Shall the Charter of the City of St. Albans, as amended, be further amended to change the City Clerk position from an elected position to one appointed by the City Council, effective July 1, 2022, through the amendment of City Charter § 12, as follows:

§ 12. City Clerk

- (a) ~~Effective July 1, 2022, the City Council legal voters of the City shall appoint elect~~ a City Clerk who shall be a legal voter in the City. ~~The Clerk shall hold office for a term of two years. The City Clerk shall perform for the City the same duties devolving by law upon town clerks, except as far as the same are rendered unnecessary by this charter, and shall collect the same fees therefor to be paid into the City Treasury for the use of the City.~~
- (b) ~~In case of a vacancy in the Office of the City Clerk, the vacancy shall be filled by the City Council until the next annual meeting of the City.~~
- (b) (e) The City Clerk and Treasurer may be one and the same person.

ARTICLE 6: CHARTER AMENDMENT, CITY TREASURER

Shall the Charter of the City of St. Albans, as amended, be further amended to change the City Treasurer position from an elected position to one appointed by the City Council, effective July 1, 2022, through the amendment of City Charter § 13, as follows:

§ 13. City Treasurer

- (a) ~~Effective July 1, 2022, the City Council legal voters of the City shall appoint elect a City Treasurer who shall be a legal voter in the City. The Treasurer shall hold office for a term of two years. The City Treasurer shall have the same power and be subject to the same liabilities as are prescribed by law for town treasurers.~~
- (b) ~~In case of a vacancy in the Office of the City Treasurer, the vacancy shall be filled by the City Council until the next annual meeting of the City.~~
- (b) (e) The City Clerk and Treasurer may be one and the same person.

ARTICLE 7: TIF BOND FOR BROWNFIELD CLEANUP AT 100-120 FEDERAL STREET


Shall the City of St. Albans issue general obligation bonds or notes in an amount not to exceed five hundred thousand (\$500,000) for the purpose of financing public improvements, namely land acquisition, brownfield cleanup, utility improvements, site work, professional services, and related costs, and for the payment thereof pledge the credit of the City?

Voters are hereby notified that the above total includes up to \$100,000 in related costs to be reimbursed by the tax increment finance district, that the total amount of outstanding Tax Increment Financing District debt is \$14,923,823 million, of which \$1.57 million is related costs, and if the increment received by the City from any property tax source received by the City is insufficient to pay debt service on the indebtedness identified above, in any year for whatever reason, including a decrease in property value or repeal of a state property tax source, unless determined otherwise at the time of such repeal, the City shall remain liable for such debt service for the term of such indebtedness.
