Members of the public are encouraged to observe and participate in person, while following social distancing protocols. A Zoom channel will be provided for those who are unable to attend in person. There will be no chat function.

The following guidelines will be in effect:

- Public comment during the public comment period at the beginning of the meeting should be brief; limited to items not on the agenda; and used for making the Council aware of a situation that needs some attention. The Council will typically just receive the information and not engage in a dialogue.
- Public comment on a particular agenda item allows for a more thorough discussion. Those seeking to comment on an agenda item may do so after recognition by the presiding officer and may request recognition by raising their hand at the appropriate time. The Zoom hand raise function may be used as well. The Council will no longer follow a roll call method for recognizing those that wish to speak.
- Members of the public seeking to comment during the in person meeting will need to speak into a microphone and wear a mask so that the comment can be heard on the Zoom channel.
- All public comment periods are subject to reasonable time limits established by the chair based on the number of people seeking to comment, the length of the agenda, and the time allotted for the subject matter.
