




## St. Albans Police Department Annual Crime Comparisons Jan. 1, 2014 Thru Dec. 31, 2014

# CALENDAR YEAR

### During the Calendar year 2014 the St. Albans Police Department:

- ◆ Responded to 12,348 calls for police service (+19% increase over 2013). Of those calls 3,827 were calls for Police Service in the Town of St. Albans (20% increase over 2013) and 8,521 calls were for Police Services in the City (+21% increase).
  - St. Albans Town incidents represent 31% of the total calls for service handled by the St. Albans Police Department in fiscal year 2014. The same percentage as in 2013.



- ◆ Made 716 Arrest (+15% increase over 2013), 647 Adult and 69 Juveniles
  - 210 Arrest were in the Town of St. Albans (+35% increase over 2013). The arrest made in the Town represents 29% of total arrest made by SAPD.
  - 506 Arrest were in the City of St. Albans (+8% increase over 2013). The arrest made in the City represents 71% of total arrest made by SAPD.
  - 538 of these arrest were Males (75%)
  - 178 were Females (25%)
  
- ◆ Took 137 public inebriates into protective custody (Detox)
  - 14 Public Inebriates were in the Town of St. Albans ( Represents 10% of total)
  - 123 Public Inebriates were in the City of St. Albans (Represents 90% of total)
  - 109 were Male (80%)
  - 28 were Female (20%)
  
- ◆ Conducted 3,506 Motor Vehicle stops (+41% increase over 2013) which resulted in the issuance of 1,018 (29%) of total motor vehicle stops.
  - 550 tickets were issued in the City of St. Albans (+44% increase over 2013).
  - 468 tickets were issued in the Town of St. Albans (+60% increase over 2013).

The total number of warnings issued for MV Offenses was 2,087 in 2014.

- 1,281 M.V. infraction Warnings were issued in the City of St. Albans (+0.44% increase over 2013).
- 806 M.V. infraction Warnings were issued in the Town of St. Albans (+28% increase over 2013).

**Traffic Tickets issued in the Town of St. Albans represents 46% of the total number of tickets issued by SAPD in 2014.**

- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to 471 Motor Vehicle Accidents in 2014
  - 225 occurred in the City (48%)
  - 246 occurred in the Town (52%)

- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department arrested 85 suspects for DUI in 2014 (+13% increase over 2013).
  - 59 occurred in the City (69%)
  - 26 occurred in the Town (31%)
  
- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department charged 88 M.V. Operators with DLS in 2014.
  - 58 occurred in the City (66%)
  - 30 occurred in the Town (34%)
  
- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 7 Armed Robberies in 2014.
  - 6 occurred in the City (86%)
  - 1 occurred in the Town (14%)
  
- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 218 Juvenile Incidents in 2014.
  - 143 occurred in the City (66%)
  - 75 occurred in the Town (34%)

- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 33 Sex Offense Incidents in 2014.
  - 19 occurred in the City (58%)
  - 14 occurred in the Town (42%)
  
- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department conducted 22 Death Investigations in 2014.
  - 16 occurred in the City (73%)
  - 6 occurred in the Town (27%)
  
- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 322 Domestic Disturbances and Domestic related crimes in 2014.
  - 234 occurred in the City (73%)
  - 88 occurred in the Town (27%)

- ◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 108 Vandalism incidents in 2014.
  - 72 occurred in the City (67%)
  - 36 occurred in the Town (33%)
- ◆ Officers issued 1,474 Parking Tickets
  - 1,465 in the City of St. Albans (99%)
  - 9 in the Town of St. Albans (1%)
- ◆ Conducted 348 (Documented) foot patrols in and around the downtown business district and in the Town of St. Albans (I.E.; Highgate Shopping Center, Price Chopper Shopping Plaza, Franklin Park West, Cohan Park, Bay Park, etc.).
- ◆ Conducted 20,075 Security Checks (I.E; Critical Infrastructure, Businesses and Requested Personal Properties).
- ◆ St. Albans Police Officers attended 2,968 hours of mandatory (in-service) and/or specialized training in criminal justice, enhanced areas of law enforcement related fields (I.E.; Death Investigation Training, Tactical Entry Training, Interview and Interrogation training, etc.), emergency services and National NIMS and ICS required training.
- ◆ Performed specialized policing and security details for:
  - St. Albans Maple Festival
  - Collins/Perley Home Show
  - Bay Day-4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration and Activities
  - Variety of athletic activities at St. Albans Schools and the Collins Perley Sports Complex
  - Vermont State Fire Fighters Convention at Collins Perley Sports Complex
  - BFA Graduation


- St. Albans City-Kingman Street Car Show

◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 226 calls at Walmart this past year, for a total of 163 Hours and 28 minutes of response and investigative time.


◆ The St. Albans Police Department responded to and investigated 63 calls at S.O.A.R. in 2014 for a total of 46 Hours of response and investigative time.

◆ In reviewing all of the VALCOUR data the busiest day of the week in the Town is Fridays, In the City it is Mondays. However in reviewing the combined Fridays continued to be the busiest day of the week.

## CENTRAL DISPATCH REGIONAL DISPATCH & E911 CALL CENTER (2014)

During 2014 Central Dispatch was responsible for alerting, and providing emergency communications for 19,905 Police, Fire and Rescue calls throughout Franklin and Grand Isle Counties and the Town of Westford, Vermont. Central Dispatch also handled 24,163 E-911 Calls and 72,478 informational and contact telephone calls. There were many more occasions where Central Dispatch provided radio testing, training and less formal emergency communications services, telephone and radio, to these same Emergency Entities.

Collectively Central Dispatch handled **116,546** Police, Fire and EMS emergency and informational of calls in calendar year 2014.
